- Anyone can participate; families, schools, business, churches, clubs and community groups are all welcomed.
- Scarecrows should be appropriate and suitable for viewing by children and families. Those that reflect any controversial or political situations will not be accepted.
- Scarecrows must be entirely made by the entrants. Commercially made scarecrows will not be allowed.
- Scarecrows must be freestanding or supported by a prop such as a hay bale. Each entrant will be provided one hay bale on setup day. Displays cannot be propped against items such as light poles or trash cans.
- Scarecrow and entire display should fit in the provided area of 3' x 7'.
- Event Organizers will determine the location for your scarecrow and notify you by email.
- Event Organizers will provide consistent signage identifying the name of the scarecrow and the sponsor.
- Scarecrows will be subject to the weather and damage may occur.
- **Marion Downtown! /Event Organizers are not responsible for loss, stolen, or damaged scarecrows.**
- The entrants are responsible for all clean up in their area after the conclusion of the event. Scarecrows not removed by November 1st will be removed by event officials and discarded. Hay bales will be picked up by event organizers if necessary.
- Public voting and a panel of judges will determine winners this year. Winners will be announced for People's Choice, First Place, Second Place and Third Place in the newspaper and social media.
- I give Marion Downtown! / Event Organizers and the public permission to take pictures of my scarecrow and myself or group.
- Entrants need to be on time and present at all important dates.
