The transfer station / landfill will accept brush and tree limbs, but it must be separated and taken to another location on the site.

If large pieces are brought, no logs are accepted, and no bigger than 6 inches in diameter. No tree stumps are accepted.

Barrels are accepted, but must be clean of any substance, the ends cut out, and crushed.

Propane tanks are not accepted. When fittings are taken off and the tank is cut in half it can then be taken by an individual to Berry's Iron & Metal.

If tires are placed in the dumpster, there will a separate charge for them. There is an additional charge for tires with rims. Tires must be placed on top of debris near door so they're not mixed with other material.

No hazardous waste is accepted. If tearing down a building or house, an inspection must be presented before dumping. If hazardous waste was found in the teardown debris and taken to a facility that accepts it, information about disposal is needed as well.

Liquid paint cannot be taken. It has to be completely dry. To speed up drying, add shreds of paper, kitty litter, or dirt. Once it's dry we will accept it. It can also be taken to EMI/Atkins (782-9900). There will be a charge for it.

Car batteries cannot be taken. Berry's Iron & Metal will accept these. They can also be taken to most car part businesses.

If riding lawnmowers are brought, any fuel/oil will need to be removed.

Metal is accepted but separated from other debris. This includes appliances, lawn mowers, roofing tin, etc.
